DIRECTIONS TO RANGE: From Cusseta, Georgia – Turn south onto US Hwy 27 and proceed about two miles to Riverbend Road. Turn right onto Riverbend Road and travel approximately 6 miles to the first paved road on the left, Hitchitee Creek Road. Turn left and follow the road for about two miles until you see the CRC sign on the left side of the road. From Lumpkin, Georgia – Travel north on US Hwy 27 until you come to Hitchitee Creek Road, which is just north of Louvale. Turn left onto Hitchitee Creek Road and travel about two miles until you come to the CRC sign on the right side of the road.

RULES: NRA rules will govern.

COMPETITION OPEN TO: All

REGISTRATION FEE: \$10.00 for juniors, \$15.00 for all others. Registration fee includes the \$4.50 NRA fee and lunch.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 30 minutes prior to the match.

ENTRY LIMIT: 20 shooters in two relays.

FIRING STARTS: 2:00 P.M. or when lunch is complete, whichever is later. Lunch will begin upon completion of the highpower match or 12:30, whichever is earlier.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. Classes will not be combined. Unclassified shooters will compete in the Master Class. NRA temporary score books will be available to unclassified shooters to use for temporary classification in future matches.

AWARDS: No awards.

RIFLES: Any rifle, Rule 3.2; metallic or telescopic sights, Rules 3.7(a) & 3.7(b).

AMMUNITION: Rule 3.17. Any safe .22 Short, .22 Long, or .22 Long Rifle ammunition except hollow point, incendiary or tracer bullets.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS: ECI's will be used to indicate there is not a round in the chamber. Match director will make ECIs available to shooters who do not have them.

SCORES REPORTED: Scores will be reported to the NRA.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Match 1: 50 yards - 20 rounds with unlimited sighters in 20 minutes, A-23/5 target.

Match 2 50 yards – 20 rounds with unlimited sighters in 20 minutes, A-27 target.

Match 3: Dewar Course – 20 rounds with unlimited sighters in 20 minutes on the A-23/5 target and 20 rounds with unlimited sighters in 20 minutes on the A-25 target.

Match 4 Aggregate of matches 1-3.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Additional rifles, ammunition and other equipment will be available at the range for competitors who need it. Ammunition will be provided at cost to adults and free to juniors. New shooter training will be available from an NRA certified instructor at 9:00 a.m. the morning of the match. There is no cost for the training. Shooters who have never shot in competition will be required to undergo training in order to shoot in the match. Water and latrine facilities are available on the range. There are no other services or facilities available on the range. Lunch will be provided to competitors.
