Company A

\*March 13 to June 30, 1862 (dated Sept. 12, 1862)

Near Garhams

\*June 30 to July 31, 1862 (dated Dec. 1862)

Murfreesboro, Tenn

\*Nov. and Dec. 1862

Near Tullahoma, Tennessee

\*Jan. and Feb. 1863

Near Manchester, Tenn.

Engaged in the battle near Murfreesboro. Friday 2 day of January 1863. Marched from Murfreesboro to Tullahoma. Thence to Manchester. Nothing else of interest as to the marches or station. Distance marched nearly 60 miles.

\*March and April 1863

Manchester, Tennessee

The company marched on the night of 21 of April 1863 on a scout in the direction of McMinnville, Tenn. 9 or 10 miles and returned the next morning to Manchester.

\*May and June 1863 (dated Aug. 10, 1863)

Camp Hurricane Mississippi

\*June 30 to Oct. 31, 1863

Camp Hewitt Tennessee

Company A left Hurricane near Morton, Miss. Aug. 26, 1863 by rail and landed at Tyner Station Tenn. Sept. 2 and on 5 inst. left for Chattanooga. Stayed for one night then left for Lafayette, Ga. on 6th inst. the company did considerable marching from Lafayette towards Rome, Ga. and back again in this condition it remained until about 17. Inst. when it was ordered to Chickamauga River and on 20 inst. went into the fight and suffered considerable. After the fight traveled to Missionary Ridge and remained there until the 20 October. Thence to Tyner Station where it is at present.

\*November and December 1863

Morristown, Tennessee

Company A left Chattanooga Nov. 19 and traveled down the Lookout Mountain and on 20 marched back and was ordered immediately to Knoxville. This was a hard march. On Dec. 4 retreated from Knoxville and on the 14 Dec went into fight with the enemy at Beans Station 45 miles N.E. of Knoxville. Afterwards crossed the Holston River and went into winter quarters where we are at this time.

\*Jan. and Feb. 1865

Petersburg, Va.

Since the 31 of December 1864 Company A has been in the trenches in front of Petersburg, Va.
