*March 28 to June 30 1862 (dated Sept. 16, 1862)
Near Grahams

*June 30 to July 31 1862 (dated Dec. 4, 1862)
Murfreesboro, Tenn.

*Nov. and Dec. 1862 (dated Feb. __, 1863)
Tullahoma, Tennessee

*Jan. and Feb. 1863
Manchester, Tennessee
The company was engaged in the battle of Murfreesboro, Tenn.
Marched from Murfreesboro to Alisona a distance of 45 miles.
From Alisona to Tullahoma 8 miles. From Tullahoma to Manchester
11 miles. At which last named place it is now camped.

*March and April 1863
Manchester, Tenn.
The company marched some 10 miles in the direction of McMinnville
on the night of 21 Apr. and returned to camp the 22.

*May and June 1863 (dated Aug. 10, 1863)
Near Morton, Miss.
On the 1st July marched in the direction of Vicksburg 25 miles
and on the 7th returned to Jackson and were in the fortifications
until the 16th. We then marched to the present camp near Morton.

*July 1 to Oct. 31 1863
Tyners Station
Company E marched from Jackson to Bolton and back. From there to
Morton, Miss. in the month of July. Changed station from Miss. to
the Army of Tennessee by railway August 26-31, 1863. Marched
from Tyners Station to Lafayette, Ga by way of Chattanooga and to
Missionary Ridge near Chattanooga and was in the battle of Chick-
amauga Sept. 20, 1863.

*Nov. and Dec. 1863
Morristown, Tennessee
The company left Chattanooga Nov. 22 and arrived at Knoxville
Tenn. Nov. 26, 1863. Supported the charge at Knoxville on 29
Nov. 1863. Was in the engagement at Beans Station on the 14th
Dec. 1863 and since encamped near Manchester, Tenn.

*July and August 1864
Petersburg, Va.
Since last muster the company has remained in the entrenchments
in front of Petersburg, Va.

*Jan. and Feb. 1865
Petersburg, Va.
