I, Alexander Smith clerk of the circuit court and ex officio clerk of the court of Probate in and for the county of Randolph aforesaid do hereby certify that the announced and foregoing is a true and correct copy of the will and Probate thereof, of William Looney, deceased as appears of Record in my office.

Know all men by these present that we Absalom Looney, and Epps Looney, as principal, and William I Looney, Michael Looney and David Ferrell, of ?????? P.P. Burton, John Hutchison as securities, are held and bound unto the State of Arkansas in the sum of Twenty Six Thousand dollars, lawful money, to the payment whereof will and truly to be made, have bind ourselves, our and each of our heirs executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Signed and sealed this 11th day of May A.D. 1846.

Conditioned, that if the above Absalom Looney, and Epps Looney, executors of the last will and testament of William Looney, deceased, shall make on cause to be made a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits, of the said William Looney, which have or may come to the *hands popesion* (?), or knowledge of them the said Absalom Looney and Epps Looney, and the same so made shall return and,
