

exhibit in the office of the clerk of the court of Probate of the county of Randolph within sixty days from this date, and shall faithfully execute said last will and said testator, and pay his debts and the legacies given by said will, as far as his attests will execute and the law correct, and further, make or cause to be made just and true accounts of their executorship, and make due and proper settlement thereof from time to time according to law, or the lawful order sentence, or decree of any court having competent jurisdiction; and shall more over will and truly do and perform all other matters and things touching such executorship as are or may be prescribed by law or informed on such executors by the lawful order, sentence, or decree of any court having competent jurisdiction; then this bond to be void, else to remain in full force.
