This day personally appeared B. F. Payne, Jonathan Looney and Ezekiel Rice all of the county of Randolph and State of Arkansas, before me Thomas A. Marr, clerk of the circuit court and ex officio clerk of the court of Probate in and for the county and state aforesaid each of whom (Payne, Looney and Rice) are personally and well known to me, and whose names appear as witnesses to the above last will and testament of William Looney, deceased, and they the said Payne, Looney, and Rice, bring by me first duly sworn deposed and sayeth, that they subscribed their names to the above last will and testament of the said William Looney as witnesses to the same, at the request of the said testator and furthermore these deponents sayeth that William Looney did subscribe his name to the above and foregoing will in the presence of us viz B. F. Payne, Jonathan Looney, and the other deponent Ezekiel Rice, deposed that he was requested to subscribe his name to the above last will and testament of the said William Looney died by the testator who acknowledged the same to have been previously subscribed by him for the uses and purposes therein specified and that they all to wit, B. F. Payne, Jonathan Looney, & Ezekiel Rice did subscribe their names as witnesses to the above will at the instance and by the request of the said testator, and declaring the said will to be his last will and testament, and furthermore the said deponents swore that agreeably to their knowledge and belief the said testator William Looney was at the time of making and subscribing the above will of a sound and disposing mind and furthermore these deponents sayeth not.
