in the office of the clerk of the court
of Probate of the county of Randolph,
within sixty days from this date, and
shall faithfully execute said last will
of said testator, and pay his debts and
the legacies given by said will, as
far as his assets will extend and the
law direct, and further, make or cause
to be made just and true accounts of
their executorship, and make due and
proper settlement thereof from time to time,
