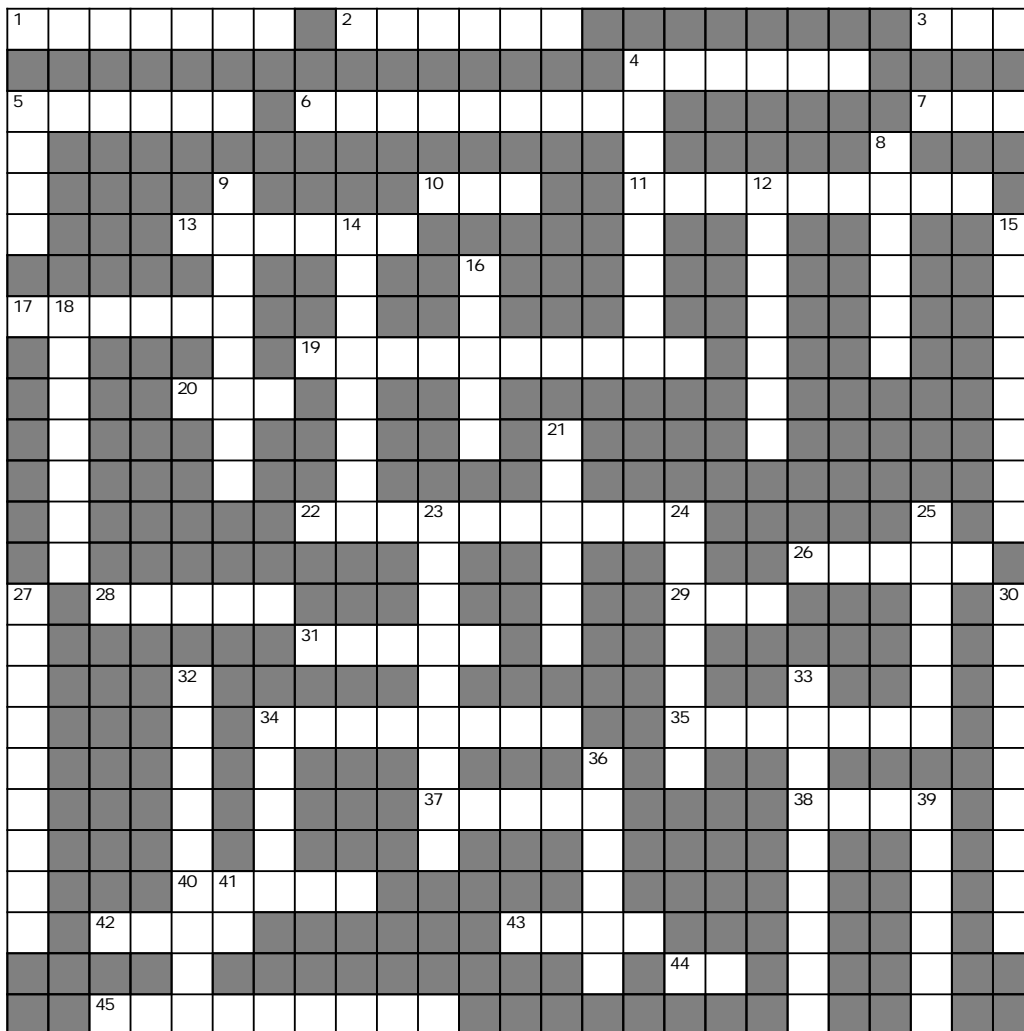

| <p>1 ** POWERS INCLUDED GERMANY, AUSTRIA-HUNGARY, BULGARIA, AND TURKEY (OTTOMAN EMPIRE)</p> <p>2 NATION THAT EXPERIENCED A MARXIST REVOLUTION DURING THE WAR, IT HAD BEEN RULED BY CZARS FOR THREE HUNDRED YEARS, IN 1918 IT PULLED OUT OF THE WAR</p> <p>3 AMERICAN FORCES IN EUROPE, LED BY GEN. PERSHING, CONSIDERED BY THE ALLIES AS BADLY PREPARED AND TRAINED, THEIR NUMBERS DISCOURAGED THE GERMANS, OVER 130,000 WOULD DIE</p> <p>4 ** PLEDGE BY GERMANY DELAYED AMERICA'S ENTRY INTO THE WAR UNTIL 1917</p> <p>5 ** WARFARE WOULD BE THE GRIM REALITY FOR MOST OF THE SOLDIERS ON THE WESTERN FRONT, EXTENDING FROM SWITZERLAND TO THE ENGLISH CHANNEL</p> | <p>6 ** WAS SIGNED IN NOVEMBER 1918 TO END THE WAR, GERMANY SURRENDERS</p> <p>7 POISON ** WAS USED TO TERRORIZE SOLDIERS, MUSTARD AND CHLORINE WERE FAVORITES</p> <p>10 A KILLER ** EPIDEMIC SPREAD WORLDWIDE AT THE END OF THE WAR, KILLING FORTY MILLION, INCLUDING 500,000 AMERICANS</p> <p>11 HIGH ** TRIGGERED LABOR UNREST IN THE WAR YEARS AND AFTERWARDS, COST OF LIVING DOUBLED</p> <p>13 DURING WAR ANTI-** FEELINGS RAN HIGH IN USA BECAUSE OF BRITISH AND AMERICAN PROPAGANDA, SUB ATTACKS</p> <p>17 BRITAIN, FRANCE AND RUSSIA DURING THE WAR (RUSSIA DROPS OUT AFTER THE REVOLUTION OF 1917), USA JOINS IN 1917</p> <p>19 ** NOTE OR TELEGRAM WAS GERMANY'S ATTEMPT TO URGE MEXICO TO FIGHT USA, AND PERHAPS REGAIN TEXAS, ARIZONA, AND NEW MEXICO</p> | <p>20 GOVERNMENT AGENCY THAT VIRTUALLY TOOK CONTROL OF THE AMERICAN ECONOMY, IT DETERMINED WHAT WAS PRODUCED, HOW, AND FOR HOW MUCH</p> <p>22 TREATY OF ** ENDED THE WAR, STRIPPED GERMANY OF ITS COLONIES AND REQUIRED HEAVY REPARATIONS, LAYING THE SEEDS FOR WW2</p> <p>26 INCOME, EXCESS PROFITS, AND EXCISE ** WERE RAISED AND USED TO HELP PAY FOR THE WAR IN THE USA, ABOUT \$11 BILLION</p> <p>28 LIBERTY ** WERE SOLD TO HELP PAY FOR THE WAR EFFORT IN THE USA, OVER \$20 BILLION WERE SOLD WITH THE HELP OF VOLUNTEERS AND MOVIE STARS</p> <p>29 ** SCARE OF 1919 LED TO MASS ARRESTS AND DEPORTATIONS, STRIKES AND RACIAL VIOLENCE TOOK PLACE</p> <p>31 HEADED UP COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC INFORMATION TO "SELL" THE WAR TO THE AMERICAN PUBLIC, THEIR PROPAGANDA WAS EFFECTIVE IN PROMOTING ANTI-GERMAN FEELINGS</p> |

34 ** POINTS INCLUDED FREEDOM OF THE SEAS, RIGHT TO SELF-GOVERNANCE, OPEN DIPLOMACY, LEAGUE OF NATIONS, AND DISARMAMENT

35 TRIPLE ** CONSISTED OF FRANCE, UNITED KINGDOM, AND RUSSIA (DURING WAR KNOWN AS THE ALLIES)

37 PANCHO **, MEXICAN BANDIT WHO ATTACKED AMERICAN TOWNS ON THE BORDER, LEADER OF MEXICAN REVOLUTION

38 SOCIALIST IMPRISONED FOR SPEAKING OUT AGAINST THE WAR, HE SPENT THE LATTER PART OF THE WAR LOCKED UP IN THE ATLANTA FEDERAL PRISON

40 SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER WILSON, HE RESIGNED HIS POSITION BECAUSE OF HIS PACIFIST BELIEFS RATHER THAN SUPPORT THE WAR EFFORT

42 ** ADMINISTRATION WAS LED BY HERBERT HOOVER, IT ENCOURAGED AMERICANS TO CONSERVE FOOD SO IT COULD BE SENT OVERSEAS TO THE ALLIES

43 FRENCH MILITARY LEADER, SUPREME COMMANDER OF ALLIED FORCES, HE WANTED PERSHING TO COMMIT AMERICAN SOLDIERS TO COMBAT UNDER FRENCH AND BRITISH LEADERSHIP

44 ** vs Schenck Supreme Court decision in 1919 ruled that in times of a "clear and present danger" constitutional rights may be limited

45 ** WAS SUNK IN 1915 BY GERMAN SUBMARINES, IT CARRIED AMERICAN PASSENGERS, SUPPLIES AND WEAPONS FOR THE ALLIES

4 ESPIONAGE AND ** ACTS WERE PASSED CRIMINALIZING ANTI-WAR SPEECH AND ACTIONS DURING THE WAR, OVER 6000 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED

5 THE ** WAS DEVELOPED BY THE BRITISH TO ATTACK GERMAN TRENCHES AND BARB WIRE

8 PRESIDENT DURING THE WAR, IN 1916 HE RAN A CAMPAIGN REMINDING AMERICAN VOTERS THAT HE KEPT THE USA OUT OF WAR, SUFFERED A STROKE IN HIS LAST YEAR OF OFFICE BUT REFUSED TO RESIGN

9 MILITARY LEADER OF AMERICAN FORCES IN EUROPE, NICKNAMED "BLACK JACK", ALSO EARLIER ATTEMPTED TO CATCH PANCHO VILLA

12 HAMBURGERS WERE RENAMED ** SANDWICHES DURING THE WAR, DACHSHUNDS BECAME ** PUPS, GERMAN NAMES WERE CHANGED OR BANNED

14 TRIPLE ** WAS MADE UP OF GERMANY, AUSTRIA-HUNGARY, AND ITALY (ITALY SWITCHED SIDES IN 1915), BECAME THE CENTRAL POWERS

15 THE ALLIES ** OF GERMANY WOULD CAUSE INCREDIBLE SUFFERING FOR THE GERMAN PEOPLE, OVER 750,000 GERMANS WOULD PERISH FROM HUNGER, USA WOULD PROTEST ITS LOSS OF FREEDOM OF THE SEAS

16 RUSSIAN TREATY OF **-LITOVSK SURRENDERED THE UKRAINE TO GERMANY IN MARCH 1918, BECAUSE RUSSIA LEFT THE WAR EARLY IT WAS LEFT OUT OF THE PEACE CONFERENCE AFTER THE WAR BY THE ALLIES (AND LED BY BOLSHIEVKS LIKE LENIN)

18 ** BONDS WERE SOLD TO HELP PAY FOR THE WAR

21 ** RAIDS WERE CARRIED OUT AFTER THE WAR TO SUPPRESS FOREIGN "RADICALS", MANY WERE DEPORTED

23 ** SERVICE ACT WAS PASSED IN MAY 1917, CONSCRIPTION ACT, 24 MILLION MEN REGISTERED WITH 3 MILLION DRAFTED THROUGH A LOTTERY, 2 MILLION ACTUALLY SERVED IN EUROPE, 3/4 SEEING COMBAT

24 POST WAR ** WERE ORGANIZED BECAUSE OF HIGH INFLATION AFTER THE WAR, OVER 3600 IN 1919, INCLUDING SOME GENERAL STRIKES

25 ** OF NATIONS WAS AN INTERNATIONAL ATTEMPT TO PREVENT WAR, USA REFUSED TO JOIN DESPITE WILSON'S EFFORTS

27 ** WARFARE BY THE GERMANS ATTEMPTED TO KNOCK BRITAIN OUT OF THE WAR, OVER 75,000 WOULD BE KILLED, IT WAS ONE REASON WHY THE USA ENTERED THE WAR IN APRIL 1917

30 THESE WERE USED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN WAR, PRIMARILY FOR SCOUTING AND LIGHT BOMBING, DOGFIGHTS CAPTURED THE IMAGINATION OF THE PUBLIC, ACES SHOT DOWN FIVE OR MORE OF THE ENEMY

32 NICKNAME FOR AMERICAN SOLDIERS, THEY WERE YOUNG, FRESH, AND UNPREPARED FOR THE REALITIES OF TRENCH WARFARE, SOME HISTORIANS BELIEVE THEY PLAYED A MINIMAL ROLE IN WINNING THE WAR

33 ARCHDUKE ** WAS ASSASSINATED IN BALKANS IN JUNE 1914, AUSTRIA-HUNGARY DECLARED WAR IN NEXT MONTH ON SERBIA WITH GERMAN ENCOURAGEMENT ("A BLANK CHECK"), RUSSIA WAS ANTAGONIZED AND BEGAN TO MOBILIZE

34 APPROXIMATELY ** THOUSAND AMERICAN SOLDIERS WERE KILLED IN WAR, TOTAL COMBAT DEAD OVER TEN MILLION, TOTAL DEAD WAS OVER 25 MILLION

36 FINANCIER WHO HEADED UP THE WAR INDUSTRIES BOARD TO COORDINATE PRODUCTION FOR THE WAR EFFORT, GOVERNMENT WOULD HAVE EXTRAORDINARY POWER TO MANAGE THE ECONOMY

39 ASSASSINS FROM ** BEGAN THE WAR, KILLING ARCHDUKE OF AUSTRIA-HUNGARY ON JUNE 28, 1914, WAR IS DECLARED EXACTLY A MONTH LATER
