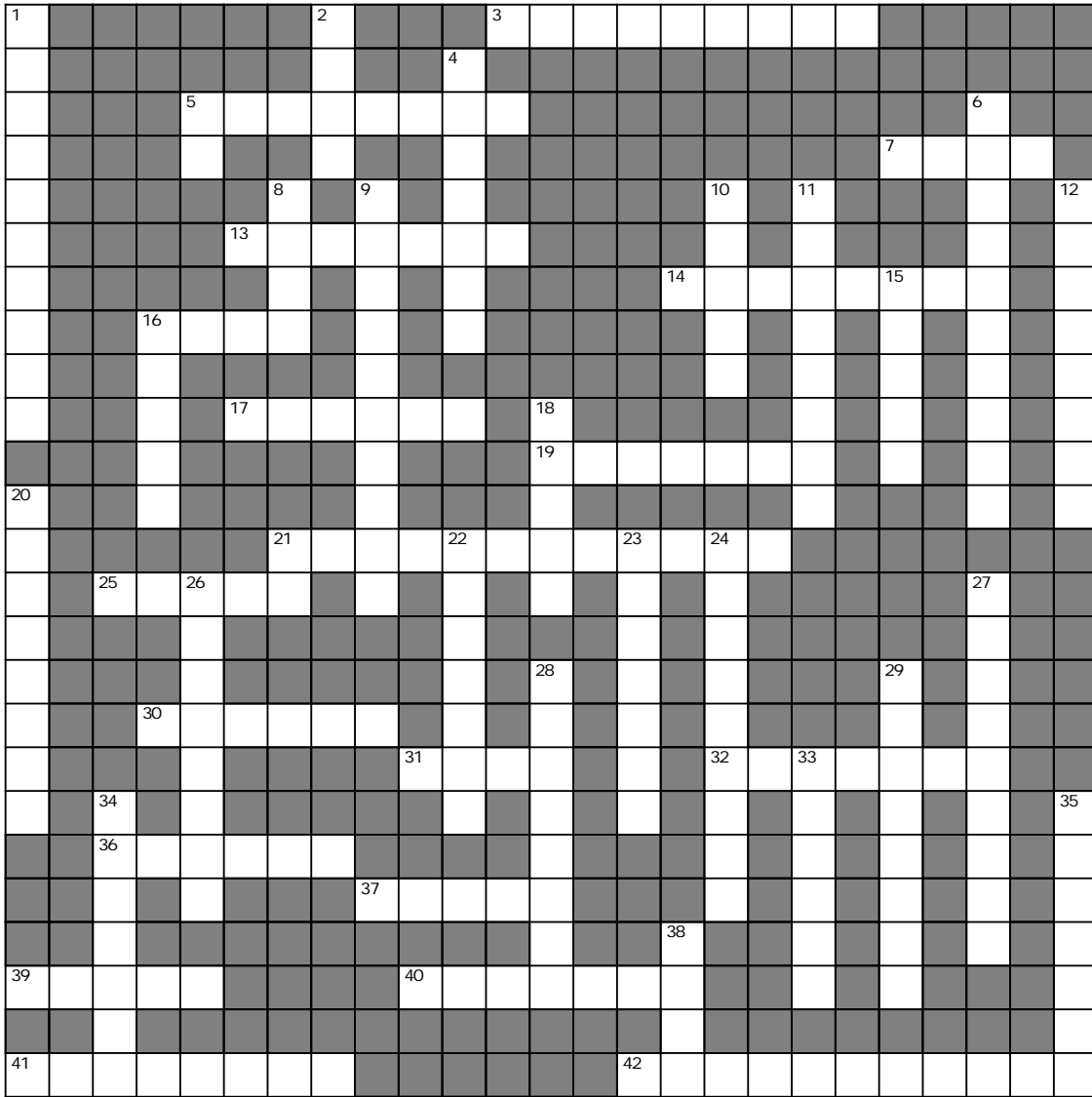


AMERICAN COLONIES EMERGE



ACROSS

- 3 ST ** IN FLORIDA IS OLDEST EUROPEAN FOUNDED CITY IN PRESENT DAY USA, ESTABLISHED IN 1565
- 5 GOVERNOR OF MASSACHUSETTS COLONY
- 7 PROPRIETOR WHO ESTABLISHED A COLONY TO FOLLOW QUAKER BELIEFS, KNOWN FOR ITS RELIGIOUS TOLERATION, HAD GOOD RELATIONS WITH NATIVES
- 13 NATIVE LEADER WHO ATTEMPTED TO BAND TOGETHER INDIAN TRIBES AGAINST THE ENGLISH IN 1760'S, ALLY OF THE FRENCH DURING THE FRENCH AND INDIAN WAR
- 14 ** CHURCH WAS THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND, FORMED BY KING HENRY VIII BECAUSE OF HIS PROBLEMS WITH THE CATHOLIC CHURCH
- 16 IMPORTANT CROP GROWN ON SOUTH CAROLINA PLANTATIONS
- 17 ROYAL ** OF NEW DISCOVERIES IN 1573 WAS SPANISH ATTEMPT TO PROVIDE ESSENTIALS OF LIFE TO NATIVE PEOPLES; ALSO FUNDAMENTAL ** OF CONNECTICUT WAS FIRST CONSTITUTION IN ENGLISH NORTH AMERICA
- 19 WAMPANOAG CHIEF KNOWN AS KING PHILIP. HE OBJECTED TO EFFORTS TO OBEY PURITAN LAWS AND RELIGION.
- 21 AZTEC CITY NOW KNOWN AS MEXICO CITY
- 25 NATHANIEL ** LED A REBELLION IN JAMESTOWN IN 1676, BURNED JAMESTOWN, HIS FOLLOWERS WERE LANDLESS AND DEBTORS, UNHAPPY WITH THE GOVERNMENT
- 30 SPANISH CONQUISTADORE WHO CONQUERED THE AZTEC EMPIRE IN 1521
- 31 PONCE DE ** WAS SPANISH EXPLORER IN FLORIDA LOOKING FOR MYTHICAL FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

32 COLONY ESTABLISHED OFF THE COAST OF PRESENT DAY NORTH CAROLINA BY SIR WALTER RALEIGH IN 1580'S, IT MYSTERIOUSLY DISAPPEARED, ONLY WORD "CROATOAN" FOUND ON TREE

36 EXPLORER WORKING FOR THE DUTCH WHO WOULD CLAIM PRESENT DAY NEW YORK

37 CREDITED WITH CROSS BREEDING TOBACCO THAT COULD BE PROFITABLY EXPORTED FROM VIRGINIA

39 ** SETTLEMENT OF NEW NETHERLAND EVENTUALLY WAS TAKEN BY THE ENGLISH AND CALLED NEW YORK

40 ** NATION OF MEXICO CONSISTS OF PEOPLE WITH MIXED EUROPEAN AND INDIAN BLOOD

41 PEOPLE WHO ESTABLISHED MASSACHUSETTS COLONY, LEFT EUROPE BECAUSE OF RELIGIOUS PERSECUTION AND SEEKING RELIGIOUS FREEDOM

42 ** WERE PURITANS WHO BELIEVED ANGLICAN CHURCH COULD NOT BE REFORMED, WOULD MOVE TO PLYMOUTH, KNOWN AS PILGRIMS

1 SHE ARGUED IN PURITAN MASSACHUSETTS THAT CLERGY WERE NOT NECESSARY IN ORDER TO WORSHIP GOD; BANISHED AS A RESULT

2 PURITANS HOPED TO BUILD A "*** UPON A HILL", SOCIETY ORGANIZED AROUND CHRISTIAN PRINCIPLES

4 MAYFLOWER ** WAS AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH A CIVIL SOCIETY AT PLYMOUTH IN 1621 THAT WOULD HAVE JUST AND EQUAL LAWS

5 WA

6 ** SERVANTS WERE PEOPLE WHO CROSSED THE ATLANTIC BY AGREEING TO WORK FOR A SPONSOR FOR 4-7 YEARS AS PAYMENT FOR PASSAGE

8 WILLIAM PENN GAVE THE RIGHT TO ** TO ALL ADULT MALES IN HIS COLONY TO INCREASE NUMBERS OF COLONISTS TO PENNSYLVANIA

9 DUTCH GOVERNOR WHO UNSUCCESSFULLY RESISTED ENGLISH EFFORT TO TAKE NEW NETHERLAND IN 1664

10 ** FE WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1610 BY SPANISH, WOULD BECOME CAPITAL OF NEW MEXICO, CONNECTED TO NEW SPAIN BY THE ROYAL ROAD

11 ESTABLISHED RHODE ISLAND COLONY, HAD FLED MASSACHUSETTS BECAUSE PURITANS BELIEVED HE WAS A DANGEROUS RADICAL, WANTED FRIENDLY RELATIONS WITH NATIVES

12 COLONY ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY SWEDISH AND FINNISH SETTLERS

15 EXPLORER WHO EXPLORED CANADA IN 1497

16 ** COLONIES WERE DIRECTLY CONTROLLED BY ENGLISH KING; MOST COLONIES BY 1770S WERE THIS INCLUDING GEORGIA

18 LEADER OF JAMESTOWN WHO PULLED THE COLONY TOGETHER TO AVERT DISASTER

20 NATIVE AMERICANS NEAR JAMESTOWN WHO FOUGHT UNSUCCESSFUL EFFORT TO RETAIN THEIR LAND IN EARLY 17TH CENTURY

22 FRENCH EXPLORER WHO EXPLORED CANADA IN 1534-5

23 KEY EXPORT THAT MADE JAMESTOWN A VIABLE COLONY

24 CITY KNOWN AS NEW ** WOULD LATER BE CALLED NEW YORK CITY, ESTABLISHED IN 1625

26 SPANISH EXPLORER WHO TRAVELLED THROUGH THE AMERICAN WEST LOOKING FOR GOLD AND SILVER

27 HOUSE OF ** IS FIRST REPRESENTATIVE LEGISLATURE IN COLONIAL AMERICA, ESTABLISHED IN 1619

28 ENGLISH LAWS OF ** ESTABLISHED A PATTERN WHERE DEFEATED PEOPLES WOULD REMAIN SEPARATE FROM THEM, NO INTERMARRIAGE ALLOWED

29 ** CONFEDERATION WAS FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY IN NORTH AMERICA, CONSISTED OF FIVE TRIBES WHICH BANDED TOGETHER

33 SPANISH ** WAS DEFEATED BY THE ENGLISH NAVY IN 1588, MARKED A SHIFT IN THE BALANCE OF POWER, AND BEGAN SPAIN'S LONG DECLINE

34 OFFICIAL PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ENGLISH COLONIES

35 KING ** WAR WAS FOUGHT IN 1670'S BETWEEN NATIVES AND PEOPLE IN NEW ENGLAND, 16 COLONIAL VILLAGES DESTROYED, 1/10 OF MEN KILLED

38 PUEBLO LEADER WHO LED REBELLION AGAINST THE SPANISH IN 1680'S IN AMERICAN SOUTHWEST
