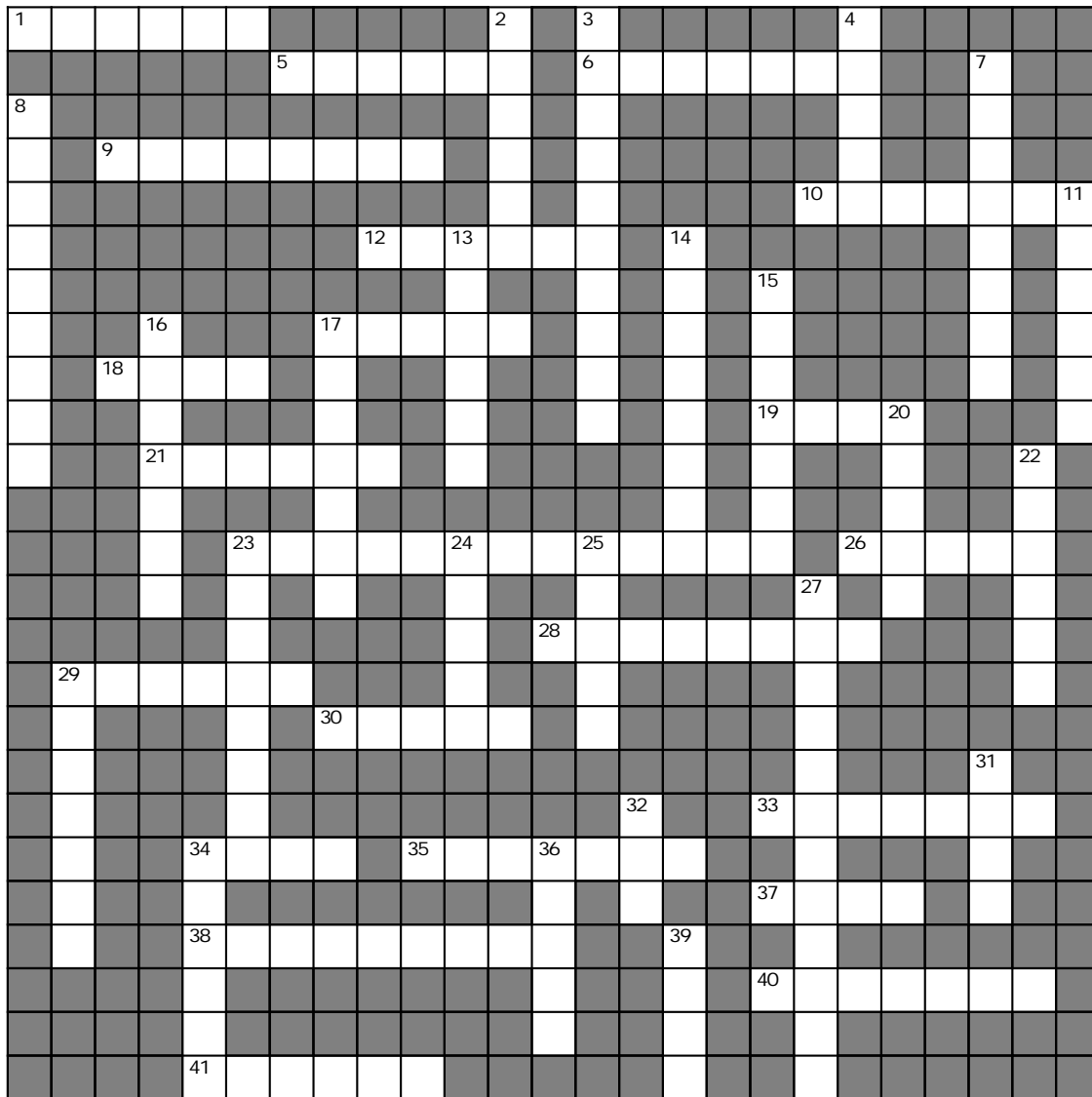

- 23 SOUTH CAROLINA'S ORDINANCE OF ** NEARLY MEANT WAR IN 1830'S, OVER HIGH TARIFFS
- 26 ** OF 1837 WAS BROUGHT ABOUT BY JACKSON'S POLICIES, WIDESPREAD UNEMPLOYMENT
- 28 ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1840, ONLY SERVED SEVEN WEEKS OR SO, WAR HERO FROM WAR OF 1812
- 29 ** CIRCULAR WAS JACKSON'S ORDER THAT PAYMENTS FOR PUBLIC LAND BE MADE IN GOLD OR SILVER, DRIED UP CREDIT, AND CAUSED PANIC OF 1837
- 30 PRESIDENT MARTIN VAN **, AFTER ANDREW JACKSON
- 33 NATION FORMED IN AFRICA TO RELOCATE AFRICAN-AMERICANS
- 34 PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE IN 1832, FORMER SPEAKER AND SECRETARY OF STATE, PUT TOGETHER A NUMBER OF COMPROMISES
- 35 INVENTOR OF COTTON GIN, AND DEVELOPED USE OF STANDARDIZED PARTS
- 37 SECOND U.S. ** CHARTERED FROM 1816-1836
- 38 ** COLLEGE SELECTS THE PRESIDENT EVERY FOUR YEARS
- 40 JACKSON'S NICKNAME WAS "OLD **"
- 41 BROUGHT TEXTILE MILL PLANS TO AMERICA IN HIS HEAD, ESTABLISHED FIRST MILL IN RHODE ISLAND IN 1791

- 20 FUTURE STATE THAT DECLARED ITS INDEPENDENCE FROM MEXICO IN 1836, LONE STAR REPUBLIC
- 22 TYPE OF VETO THAT OCCURS WITHIN 10 DAYS OF CONGRESSIONAL ADJOURNMENT, NO OVERRIDE POSSIBLE
