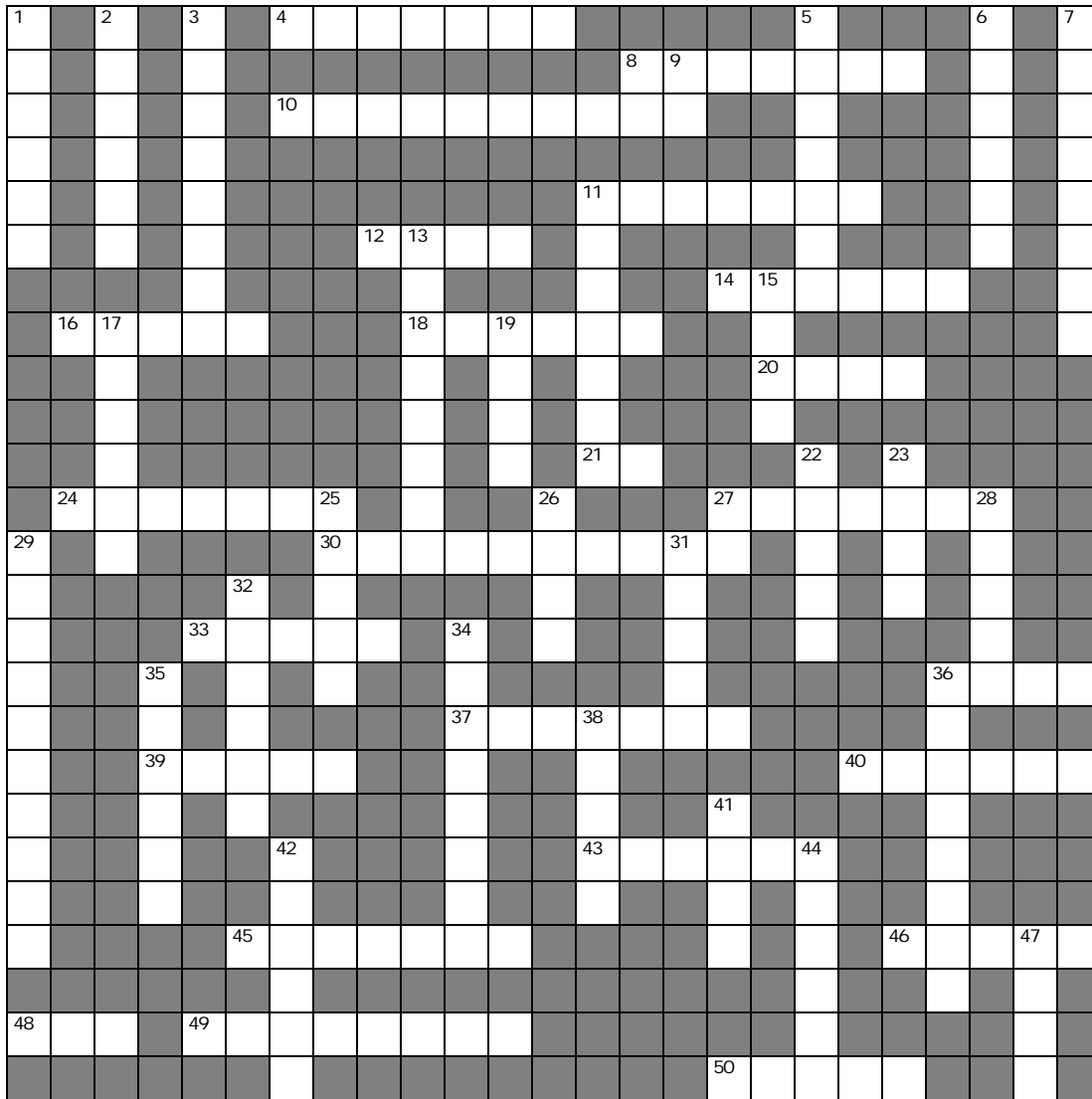


## Manifest Destiny

| <p>4 AT THE BATTLE OF SAN ** OVER 630 MEXICAN SOLDIERS WERE KILLED AND SANTA ANNA WAS TAKEN HOSTAGE AND FORCED TO SIGN THE TREATY OF VELASCO GRANTING TEXAN INDEPENDENCE, IN 1836</p> | <p>11 TEXAN LEADER WHO DEFEATED MEXICAN TROOPS AT BATTLE OF SAN JACINTO SIX WEEKS AFTER THE ALAMO, SANTA ANNA WAS FORCED TO AGREE TO TEXAN INDEPENDENCE, 1ST PRESIDENT OF TEXAS, LATER US SENATOR</p> | <p>18 SHE LED MANY ESCAPED SLAVES OUT OF THE SOUTH WITH UNDERGROUND RAILROAD, CALLED "MOSES" FOR HER 19 TRIPS INTO THE SOUTH</p>                        | <p>27 FIRST REPUBLICAN CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT, IN 1856, HE HAD MAPPED THE OREGON TRAIL AND LED TROOPS IN CALIF DURING THE WAR</p>   |
| <p>8 LEADING SOUTHERN REGIONAL LEADER, FORMER VICE PRESIDENT UNDER ADAMS AND JACKSON</p>  | <p>12 ** NOTHING PARTY, ALSO KNOWN AS THE AMERICAN PARTY, WAS ANTI-IMMIGRANT AND NATIVIST</p>   | <p>20 SANTA **, MEXICAN GENERAL AND DICTATOR WHO WAS CAPTURED AT BATTLE OF SAN JACINTO, LATER DURING MEXICAN AMERICAN WAR HE WOULD FLEE THE COUNTRY</p> | <p>30 ** OF 1850 CONSISTED OF ADMITTING CALIF TO UNION AS A FREE STATE, STRENGTHENING FUGITIVE SLAVE LAW, ENDING SLAVE TRADE IN WASH DC AND PROVIDING FOR POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY IN UTAH AND NEW MEXICO</p> |
| <p>10 ** PARTY WAS FORMED IN THE 1850'S TO PREVENT THE EXPANSION OF SLAVERY INTO THE WESTERN TERRITORIES</p>  | <p>14 EARLY LEADER OF AMERICANS IN TEXAS, ISSUED NEARLY 300 LAND GRANTS, AND WAS IMPRISONED IN MEXICO FOR INCITING REVOLUTION</p>   | <p>21 OL</p>  | <p>33 ** ANNA WAS MEXICAN GENERAL WHO SURRENDERED TO SAM HOUSTON IN 1836 AND GRANTED INDEPENDENCE TO TEXAS, LATER HE WAS A DICTATOR OF MEXICO</p>  |
|   | <p>16 MORMON LEADER WHO REPLACES JOSEPH SMITH AND ESTABLISHES A SETTLEMENT NEAR THE GREAT SALT LAKE IN 1847</p>   | <p>24 INTRODUCED A BILL TO DIVIDE THE KANSAS AND NEBRASKA TERRITORIES WHICH WOULD REPEAL THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE AND ALLOW FOR POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY</p>  |  |

- 36 \*\* SOIL PARTY CHOSE FORMER PRES. VAN BUREN AS ITS CANDIDATE IN 1848, WON 10% OF POPULAR VOTE
- 37 \*\* PURCHASE IN 1853 FROM MEXICO ADDED SOUTHERN ARIZONA AND SOUTHERN NEW MEXICO TO USA FOR \$10 MILLION
- 39 BATTLE FOUGHT IN SAN ANTONIO IN EARLY 1836: TEXANS VS MEXICANS, BECOMES A RALLYING CRY FOR INDEPENDENCE, 187 TEXANS WERE KILLED
- 40 \*\* PROVISIO WOULD HAVE PROHIBITED SLAVERY IN LAND OBTAINED FROM MEXICO, INSTEAD POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY WOULD DETERMINE ITS STATUS AS PART OF THE COMPROMISE OF 1850
- 43 WAR HERO ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1848 AS A WHIG CANDIDATE, HE DIED AFTER A COUPLE OF YEARS IN OFFICE
- 45 REGIONAL POLITICAL LEADER FROM MASSACHUSETTS WHO WAS STRONGLY ANTI-SLAVERY AND PRO-UNION, CONSIDERED ONE OF OUR GREAT ORATORS
- 46 JOHN \*\* WOULD BE INVOLVED IN ANTI-SLAVERY VIOLENCE IN KANSAS, LATER WOULD ATTEMPT TO SEIZE A FEDERAL ARMORY IN VIRGINIA
- 48 \*\* FRANCISCO WAS THE JEWEL OF CALIFORNIA BECAUSE OF ITS DEEP HARBOR, THE USA WAS DETERMINED TO KEEP IT FROM FALLING INTO FOREIGN HANDS AND TO TAKE IT FROM MEXICO BY PURCHASE OR CONQUEST
- 49 ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1856; DID NOTHING TO PREVENT THE CIVIL WAR THAT WOULD COME
- 50 INVENTED THE TELEGRAPH IN 1837, WOULD SEND FIRST MESSAGE IN 1844 "WHAT HATH GOD WROUGHT?" FROM WASHINGTON TO BALTIMORE

- 1 SHORTLY AFTER THE ALAMO ANOTHER 445 TEXANS WOULD BE KILLED BY THE MEXICAN ARMY AT THE BATTLE OF \*\*
- 2 MANY AMERICAN SOUTHERNERS WHO MOVED TO TEXAS BROUGHT THEIR \*\*, THIS WOULD BE A SOURCE OF CONFLICT ONCE MEXICO BANNED SLAVERY IN 1829
- 3 NEWSPAPER MAN WHO WROTE OF MANIFEST DESTINY, THE DIVINE PLAN FOR THE USA TO EXPAND ACROSS THE CONTINENT
- 5 RELIGIOUS GROUP THAT WAS PERSECUTED IN THE EAST, EVENTUALLY SETTLED IN DESERET, NOW KNOWN AS UTAH
- 6 THE \*\* REVOLUTION GAINED MOMENTUM IN THE 1840S AS INCREASING NUMBERS OF AMERICANS WERE EMPLOYED IN THE PRODUCTION OF GOODS AND SERVICES FOR CONSUMERS, IN FACTORIES, MILLS, ETC.
- 7 \*\* DESTINY WAS THE CONCEPT THAT MANY AMERICANS BELIEVED IN THE 1840S THAT THE USA WAS SUPPORTED BY GOD'S WILL THAT THE USA SHOULD EXPAND ACROSS THE CONTINENT

- 9 AN
- 11 TREATY OF GUADALUPE \*\* WAS SIGNED IN 1848, MEXICO WOULD LOSE ITS NORTHERN HALF OF THE COUNTRY TO USA
- 13 THE FAVORING OF NATIVE BORN AMERICANS OVER IMMIGRANTS, AS EXPRESSED BY ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS THE ORDER OF THE STAR SPANGLED BANNER
- 15 \*\* TERRITORY WAS SETTLED BY MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH OF LATTER DAY SAINTS IN 1840'S
- 17 THE \*\* COUNTRY WAS JOINTLY OCCUPIED BY BRITAIN AND USA, AND WAR WAS AVOIDED WITH A TREATY IN 1846, BOUNDARY WOULD BE 49TH PARALLEL, THE USA WOULD NOW INCLUDE WASHINGTON, OREGON, IDAHO, MONTANA AND WYOMING
- 19 \*\* FLAG REPUBLIC WAS PROCLAIMED BY STEPHEN KEARNY AS AN ACT OF INDEPENDENCE IN CALIF. DURING THE WAR
- 22 HE DEVELOPED A STEEL PLOW WHICH WAS NECESSARY FOR THE TOUGH, DRY SOIL OF THE WEST
- 23 \*\* STAR REPUBLIC WON ITS INDEPENDENCE FROM MEXICO IN 1836, LATER WAS ANNEXED BY USA IN 1845 (TEXAS)
- 25 WAR HERO WHO RAN FOR PRESIDENT UNSUCCESSFULLY IN 1852; HE WAS A WAR HERO FROM THE MEXICAN-AMERICAN WAR AND IS CONSIDERED TO BE A BRILLIANT MILITARY LEADER OF THE 19TH CENTURY
- 26 ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1844, OPENLY EXPANSIONIST, AND EAGER TO SEE CALIFORNIA ENTER THE UNION
- 27 SANTA \*\* TRAIL WENT FROM MISSOURI TO NEW MEXICO, 780 MILES
- 28 VICE PRESIDENT WHO TAKES OVER FOR HARRISON AFTER HIS DEATH IN 1841; HIS TERM IS CONSIDERED A FAILURE
- 29 ECONOMIC SYSTEM IN WHICH CAPITAL IS INVESTED IN BUSINESSES, FACTORIES, MILLS, ETC TO PRODUCE GOODS AND SERVICES TO SELL TO CONSUMERS IN HOPES OF GAINING PROFITS, RISK IS INVOLVED
- 31 WROTE UNCLE TOM'S CABIN IN 1852, SHAPED PUBLIC OPINION IN THE NORTH AGAINST SLAVERY
- 32 \*\* NEBRASKA ACT IN 1854 REPEALED THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE OF 1820, WOULD PROVIDE FOR POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY TO DETERMINE SLAVERY QUESTION
- 34 \*\* SLAVE ACT PROHIBITED FUGITIVES FROM TESTIFYING ON THEIR OWN BEHALF, NOT ENTITLED TO JURY TRIAL, AND PROVIDED INCENTIVES TO FEDERAL AUTHORITIES FOR THEIR RETURN
- 35 HE LED US TROOPS AGAINST MEXICAN FORCES IN CALIF, ARIZONA, AND NEW MEXICO
- 36 VICE PRESIDENT WHO TAKES OVER FOR PRES. TAYLOR AFTER HIS DEATH; LARGELY FORGOTTEN TODAY
- 38 FIRST LEADER OF MORMONS, IN 1827, WHO WROTE BOOK OF MORMON, MURDERED BY A MOB IN 1844 IN ILLINOIS
- 41 HE PUT TOGETHER A NUMBER OF COMPROMISES IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE 19TH CENTURY AS ATTEMPTS TO AVOID REGIONAL CONFLICT
- 42 ELECTED PRESIDENT IN 1852
- 44 CYRUS MCCORMICK INVENTED THE MECHANICAL \*\*, ALLOWING ONE FARMER TO DO THE WORK OF FIVE DURING HARVESTING
- 47 \*\* PARTY FELL APART AS IT DIVIDED OVER SLAVERY QUESTION; IT ORIGINALLY AROSE IN OPPOSITION TO ANDREW JACKSON AND HIS POLICIES
